

Animal Impound

The City of Dilworth contracts with Fargo Moorhead Animal Hospital to provide housing for all impounded animals. It is a costly trip to the pound for you if your pet has been picked up by animal control...

City Fees:

- ✓ \$25 – first offense
- ✓ \$50 – second offense
- ✓ \$100 – third offense
- ✓ \$35 – If your animal does not have a city license at the time of impoundment.

Pound Fees:

- ✓ Professional Care Fee
- ✓ Daily Boarding Charges
- ✓ Rabies Shots – if no proof of current vaccination is provided
- ✓ Possible fees for various care, such as fleas or Rabies quarantine.

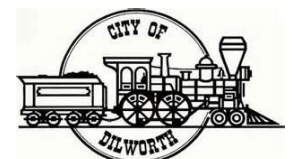

Mandatory Pet Licensing

Per Dilworth City Ordinance 90.16, "no dog or cat owner shall keep any dog or cat in the city unless a license has first been secured. Licenses shall be issued by the City Administrator upon application therefor, and payment of a fee. Each application for a license shall be accompanied by a certificate from a qualified veterinarian certifying that the dog or cat to be licensed has been given a vaccination against rabies..."

The cost of a yearly city animal license is \$5.00 if purchased before January 31st. After that date, the license fee increases to \$7.50 per year. Licenses may be purchased at City Hall M-F 8:00 am-4:30pm



City of Dilworth Animal Ordinances

§ 90.15 RUNNING AT LARGE

It shall be unlawful for the dog or cat of any person who owns, harbors or keeps a dog or cat, to run at large. A person, who owns, harbors or keeps a dog or cat which runs at large shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. Dogs or cats on a leash and accompanied by a responsible person or accompanied by and under the control and direction of a responsible person, so as to be effectively restrained by command as by leash, shall be permitted in streets or on public land unless the city has posted an area with signs reading "Dogs or Cats Prohibited".

§ 90.17 VACCINATION

No license shall be granted for a dog which has not been vaccinated against rabies during the 90-day period preceding the making of an application for such license, except that when a dog is first licensed for an entire year hereafter, the license may be issued if the dog has been vaccinated within a period of six months preceding the application for a license. The vaccination shall have been performed only by a person qualified to practice veterinary medicine in the state in which the dog was vaccinated.

§90.20 NUISANCE

(a) Habitual barking: It shall be unlawful for any person to keep or harbor a dog which habitually barks or cries. HABITUAL BARKING shall be defined as barking for repeated intervals of at least five minutes with less than one minute of interruption. The barking must also be audible off of the owner's or caretaker's premises.
